28 I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh;

Ex. 3:1 (to 1st ,)

1 NOW Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law,

Ex. 3:2 (to :)

2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush:

Ex. 3:3 (to 3rd ,)

3 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight,

Ex. 3:4 (to 2nd ,)

4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush,

1 AND it came to pass on the day that Moses had fully set up the tabernacle, and had anointed it, and sanctified it,

- 5 ¶ THERE was in the days of Herod, the king of Judæa, a certain priest named Zacharias,

- 11 And there appeared unto him an angel of the Lord

13 the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.

15 and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.

18 ¶ Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

57 Now Elisabeth's full time came that she should be delivered; and she brought forth a son.

Luke 1:80 (to 2nd ,)

80 And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit,

Luke 3:1 (to 1st ,)

1 NOW in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Cæsar,

Luke 3:2 2nd the, 3

2 the word of God came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.

3 And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;

Luke 3:7 (to multitude)

7 Then said he to the multitude

Luke 3:8 (to 1st ,)

8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance,

Luke 3:10-16 (to Ghost)

10 And the people asked him, saying, What shall we do then?

11 He answereth and saith unto them, He that hath two coats, let him impart to him that hath none; and he that hath meat, let him do likewise.

12 Then came also publicans to be baptized, and said unto him, Master, what shall we do?

13 And he said unto them, Exact no more than that which is appointed you.

14 And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse *any* falsely; and be content with your wages.

23 ¶ And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Matt. 9:9

9 ¶ And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

Matt. 9:11, 12

11 And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?

12 But when Jesus heard *that*, he said unto them, They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick.

2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

- 18 ¶ While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.
- 19 And Jesus arose, and followed him, and *so did* his disciples.

- 23 And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise,
- 24 He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn.
- 25 But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

John 14:12

- 12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

- 16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- 17 *Even* the Spirit of truth;

Acts 1:5 (to Ghost)

- 5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost

Acts 1:9 (to ;)

And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up;

Acts 2:4 (to 1st ,)

4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost,

Acts 3:1 (to temple)

1 NOW Peter and John went up together into the temple

Acts 3:2 (to 1st temple)

2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple

Acts 3:4 (to him)

4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him

Acts 3:7 took, 8

7 took him by the right hand, and lifted *him* up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

Acts 4:1 2nd and

1 and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them,

Acts 4:3 (to ,)

3 And they laid hands on them,

Acts 4:7, 8 (to 3rd ,)

7 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?

8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them,

Acts 4:10

- 10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Acts 4:13 (to ;)

- 13 ¶ Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled;

Acts 4:18

- 18 And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.

Acts 4:19

- 19 But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.

Acts 4:23 (to 2nd ,)

- 23 ¶ And being let go, they went to their own company,

Acts 4:31

- 31 ¶ And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Acts 8:5-9 (to 4th ,)

- 5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.
- 6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.
- 7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed *with them*: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.
- 8 And there was great joy in that city.

- 9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria,

Acts 8:13-20

- 13 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.
- 14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John:
- 15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:
- 16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)
- 17 Then laid they *their* hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.
- 18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,
- 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- 20 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money.

Acts 13:1 (to ;)

- 1 NOW there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers;

Acts 13:2

- 2 As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Acts 13:4 (to departed)

- 4 ¶ So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed

Acts 13:5 (to God)

- 5 And when they were at Salamis, they preached the word of God

Acts 13:48 (to :)

- 48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord:

Acts 13:49

- 49 And the word of the Lord was published throughout all the region.

Acts 11:1-4 (to 1st ,)

- 1 AND the apostles and brethren that were in Judæa heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God.
- 2 And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him,
- 3 Saying, Thou wentest in to men uncircumcised, and didst eat with them.
- 4 But Peter rehearsed *the matter* from the beginning,

Acts 11:18

- 18 When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

Rom. 8:5

- 5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

SH 588:7-8

HOLY GHOST. Divine Science; the development of eternal Life, Truth, and Love.

SH 23:12-31

- 12 Rabbinical lore said: "He that taketh one doctrine, firm in faith, has the Holy Ghost dwelling in him."
This preaching receives a strong rebuke in

15 the Scripture, “Faith without works is dead.”
 Faith, if it be mere belief, is as a pendulum swinging be-
 tween nothing and something, having no fixity. Faith,
 18 advanced to spiritual understanding, is the evidence gained
 from Spirit, which rebukes sin of every kind and estab-
 lishes the claims of God.

Doctrines and
 faith

21 In Hebrew, Greek, Latin, and English, *faith* and the
 words corresponding thereto have these two defini-
 tions, *trustfulness* and *trustworthiness*. One
 24 kind of faith trusts one’s welfare to others.
 Another kind of faith understands divine Love and how
 to work out one’s “own salvation, with fear and trem-
 27 bling.” “Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief!”
 expresses the helplessness of a blind faith; whereas the
 injunction, “Believe . . . and thou shalt be saved!”
 30 demands self-reliant trustworthiness, which includes spir-
 itual understanding and confides all to God.

Self-reliance and
 confidence

SH 29:20-26

The illumination of Mary’s spiritual sense put to
 21 silence material law and its order of generation, and
 brought forth her child by the revelation of
 Truth, demonstrating God as the Father of
 24 men. The Holy Ghost, or divine Spirit, overshadowed
 the pure sense of the Virgin-mother with the full recog-
 nition that being is Spirit.

Spiritual
 conception

SH 29:30

30 Man as the offspring of God, as the idea of Spirit,
 is the immortal evidence that Spirit is harmonious and
 man eternal. Jesus was the offspring of Mary’s self-
 30:1 conscious communion with God. Hence he could give
 a more spiritual idea of life than other men, and could
 3 demonstrate the Science of Love — his Father or divine
 Principle.

SH 30:19

As the individual ideal of Truth, Christ Jesus came to
 rebuke rabbinical error and all sin, sickness, and death, —
 21 to point out the way of Truth and Life. This

Rebukes helpful

ideal was demonstrated throughout the whole
 earthly career of Jesus, showing the difference between
 24 the offspring of Soul and of material sense, of Truth and
 of error.

SH 42:15-18

15 The resurrection of the great demonstrator of God's
 power was the proof of his final triumph over body
 and matter, and gave full evidence of divine
 18 Science, — evidence so important to mortals.

Death outdone

SH 42:28-10

Jesus had taught his disciples the
 Science of this proof. He was here to enable them to
 30 test his still uncomprehended saying, "He that believ-
 eth on me, the works that I do shall he do also." They
 must understand more fully his Life-principle by casting
 43:1 out error, healing the sick, and raising the dead, even as
 they did understand it after his bodily departure.

3 The magnitude of Jesus' work, his material disappear-
 ance before their eyes and his reappearance, all enabled
 the disciples to understand what Jesus had
 6 said. Heretofore they had only believed;
 now they understood. The advent of this understanding
 is what is meant by the descent of the Holy Ghost, — that
 9 influx of divine Science which so illuminated the Pentecos-
 tal Day and is now repeating its ancient history.

Pentecost
 repeated

SH 46:30-7

30 His students then received the Holy Ghost. By this is
 meant, that by all they had witnessed and suffered, they
 were roused to an enlarged understanding of divine Sci-
 47:1 ence, even to the spiritual interpretation and discernment
 of Jesus' teachings and demonstrations, which gave them
 3 a faint conception of the Life which is God.
 They no longer measured man by material
 sense. After gaining the true idea of their glorified Master,
 6 they became better healers, leaning no longer on matter,
 but on the divine Principle of their work.

Pentecostal
 power

SH 358:9-13

9 Christian Science, understood, coincides with the
 Scriptures, and sustains logically and demonstratively
 every point it presents. Otherwise it would
 12 not be Science, and could not present its
 proofs.

Scientific and
 Biblical facts

SH 358:15

It presents the calm and clear verdict of Truth
 against error, uttered and illustrated by the prophets,
 by Jesus, by his apostles, as is recorded throughout the
 18 Scriptures.

SH 359:3-17

3 Let any clergyman try to cure his friends by their
 faith in him. Will that faith heal them? Yet Scien-
 tists will take the same cases, and cures will follow.
 6 Is this because the patients have more faith in the Scien-
 tist than in their pastor? I have healed infidels whose
 only objection to this method was, that I as a Chris-
 9 tian Scientist believed in the Holy Spirit, while they, the
 patients, did not.

Even though you aver that the material senses are
 12 indispensable to man's existence or entity, you must
 change the human concept of life, and must at length
 know yourself spiritually and scientifically. The evi-
 15 dence of the existence of Spirit, Soul, is palpable only to
 spiritual sense, and is not apparent to the material senses,
 which cognize only that which is the opposite of Spirit.

SH 365:15-19

15 If the Scientist reaches his patient through divine
 Love, the healing work will be accomplished at one
 visit, and the disease will vanish into its native
 18 nothingness like dew before the morning sun-
 shine.

Speedy healing

SH 496:15-19

- 15 Hold perpetually this thought, — that it is the spiritual
idea, the Holy Ghost and Christ, which enables you to
demonstrate, with scientific certainty, the rule of healing,
18 based upon its divine Principle, Love, underlying, over-
lying, and encompassing all true being.
